



HISTORY

Discovered in 1419 by Portuguese explorers Tristão Vaz Teixeira, Bartolomeu Perestrelo and João Gonçalves Zarco, Madeira received its name, meaning “wood” in Portuguese, because of the large quantities of this raw material on the island.

In 1425, it began to be colonised after its strategic value was realised. Its rich soil and geographical location quickly made it a port of call for trade routes in Europe.



MADEIRA TODAY

Today, the archipelago of Madeira is a favourite destination for Portuguese people and foreign tourists alike. As well as having a mild climate throughout the year, it is a safe and peaceful area with varied cuisine and plenty of places to visit.

Madeira is home to exotic fauna and flora, and you can find species from all over the world. Its indigenous forest was classified by UNESCO as a natural World Heritage Site in 1999.





GASTRONOMY

Madeira has a varied, rich cuisine. One of the most famous dishes is the espetada Madeirense, a type of meat kebab, sides of milho frito (fried cornmeal) and bolo do caco (flat, circular bread) are some of the other delicacies that will leave your mouth watering. For those who want a taste of the sea, the limpets (lapas in Portuguese) are a must. They are cooked in a specific frying pan and seasoned with garlic and lemon. With restaurants ranging from modern to traditional, you'll be spoilt for choice.
